<b>Provision of Core Direct CAC Services</b> <i>*Multi-year award option</i>	<b>\$50,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To provide necessary support to developed CACs to ensure capacity to deliver core CAC services is maintained or increased to meet the demonstrated financial and community needs</li> </ul>
<b>Program Improvement – Meeting the 2023 National Standards</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Intended for CAC programs with well-established, stable operations that need to respond to the 2023 National Standards of Accreditation by setting trainings and practices of care that will continue to meet or exceed these increased minimum practice standards</li> </ul>

<b>Rural CAC Capacity Building and Expansion</b>	<b>\$75,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To strengthen and sustain CACs serving rural communities by addressing their unique operational challenges and supporting solutions to service delivery barriers.</li> <li>Projects must address one or more of the following priority areas identified in the 2025 Rural CAC Needs Assessment: 1. Establish an NCA Satellite member center (only Accredited CACs); 2. Expanding geographic reach through the development of mobile and teleservices; 3. Increase service capacity to meet the demonstrated need; 4. MDT Enhancement and Coordination; 5. Organizational Capacity Building</li> </ul>
<b>Equipment and Technology Support</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To support the work of CACs by purchasing or upgrading necessary equipment, including hardware, software, and related services (such as installation, etc.) for medical, forensic interviewing, medical/forensic interviewing peer review, victim advocacy, mental health, and operations (this includes first-time installation or upgrade of human resources or accounting software), and electronic OMS survey completion</li> </ul>
<b>Military Services</b> <i>New focus areas and *Multi-year award option</i>	<b>\$50,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Establish (Focus 1) or expand (Focus 2) the coordinated investigative and comprehensive response to child abuse to military families; leverage partnerships and establish protocols for serving military installations; and/or identify, develop, and operationalize best practices to help military installations address cases of child abuse</li> </ul>
<b>DTVf - Victims of CSAM and Child Sex Trafficking</b>	<b>\$75,000</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To provide necessary support to developed CACs to ensure capacity to deliver core CAC services is maintained or increased to meet demonstrated financial and community needs</li> </ul>

\*Multi-year award option: New applicants may apply for funding for a one year award. Current awardees who have projects that demonstrate continued need and successful completion of prior year deliverables may be invited to apply for one (1) additional year of funding through a new subaward.
