

GOAL

Growth and Development - To support the growth and development of new CACs and MDTs in unserved areas, the development of enhanced services by existing or emerging CACs and MDTs in underserved areas, the ongoing, comprehensive, quality services in currently served areas, and the identification and inclusion of demographic populations in all areas to increase access to quality CAC services.

OBJECTIVES/ ACTIVITIES

- 6 - Improve access to medical care by coordinating medical preceptorships, coordinating medical service coverage, and partnering with academic programs to create a pipeline of medical professionals prepared to serve abused children.
- 7 - Improve access to mental healthcare by partnering with academic programs to develop a pipeline of trained professionals, implementing tele-mental health where needed, and identifying and deploying mental health consultants, as necessary to address rural issues.
- 12 - Provide technical assistance to local communities interested in developing a CAC.
- 13 - Provide individualized consultation to CACs in their state interested in improving their services in a specific area.

OUTPUTS

1. Hire Strategic Initiatives Coordinator to work with medical and academic partners to establish at least one (1) MOU providing medical preceptorships and creating a pipeline of medical professionals prepared to serve abused children.
 2. Conduct bi-monthly virtual visits with medical providers and CAC Directors to further evaluate their current program and coverage needs.
 3. Compile key contacts and processes for internships at higher ed institutions; conduct 1 information session for CACs.
1. Hire Strategic Initiatives Coordinator to work with MH academic partners to establish at least one (1) MOU creating a pipeline of trained professionals.
 2. Work with one or more CAC to incorporate telehealth into their portfolio to provide remote therapy services.
1. Develop and implement a Readiness Assessment for those communities expressing interest in establishing a CAC and/or MDT.
 2. Chapter staff will outreach to and provide at least five (5) instances of individual TA to local communities interested in developing a CAC, providing them with a written Readiness Assessment.
 3. Create an online resource toolkit to assist communities in assessing readiness to establish a CAC.
1. Create an electronic resource library of sample materials related to the expansion and/or enhancement of services.
 2. Create a list of resource referrals specific to the request that include (ex. RCAC, NCA, and/ or nearby CAC/MDT programs) that can assist with the specific area of interest.
 3. Chapter staff will provide at least sixty (60) **documented** instances of individual TA to established CACs seeking to improve their services in a specific area.

GOAL (cont.)

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OBJECTIVES/ ACTIVITIES

- 15 - Implement statewide database, analyze state data collection, and consult with CACs on case management to improve case and child outcomes. Conduct/coordinate related HIPAA, cybersecurity, and state privacy law training and consultation. Provide support and consultation on outcome measurement system.
- 20 - Analyzes child abuse data within a state, and existing resources, to locate areas in which more MDT/CAC development or deployment of satellite services may be needed and coordinates this with existing CACs within the state.
- 21 - Develop new CACs in underserved areas of the state in partnership with local communities.

OUTPUTS

1. Increase the use of effective case tracking by enrolling 2 more CACs with Collaborate Database.
 2. Hire a Compliance coordinator who will provide support and consultation on outcome measurement system, NCAttrak reporting and provide analysis on trends.
1. Create an annual report using information gathered using Coalition Manager (or similar platform) to analyze child abuse data in the state.
 2. Update Statewide Assessment Report and analyze data to inform growth & development planning and implementation.
1. Respond to community/entity, by sending a Chapter representative to meet with the interested community/entity, as well as providing ongoing communication and support designed to assist with the development of the CAC/MDT.
 2. Identify a nearby established CAC/MDT to provide a mentor relationship with community/entity.
 3. Provide at least 40 hours of TA to 2 developing CACs.
