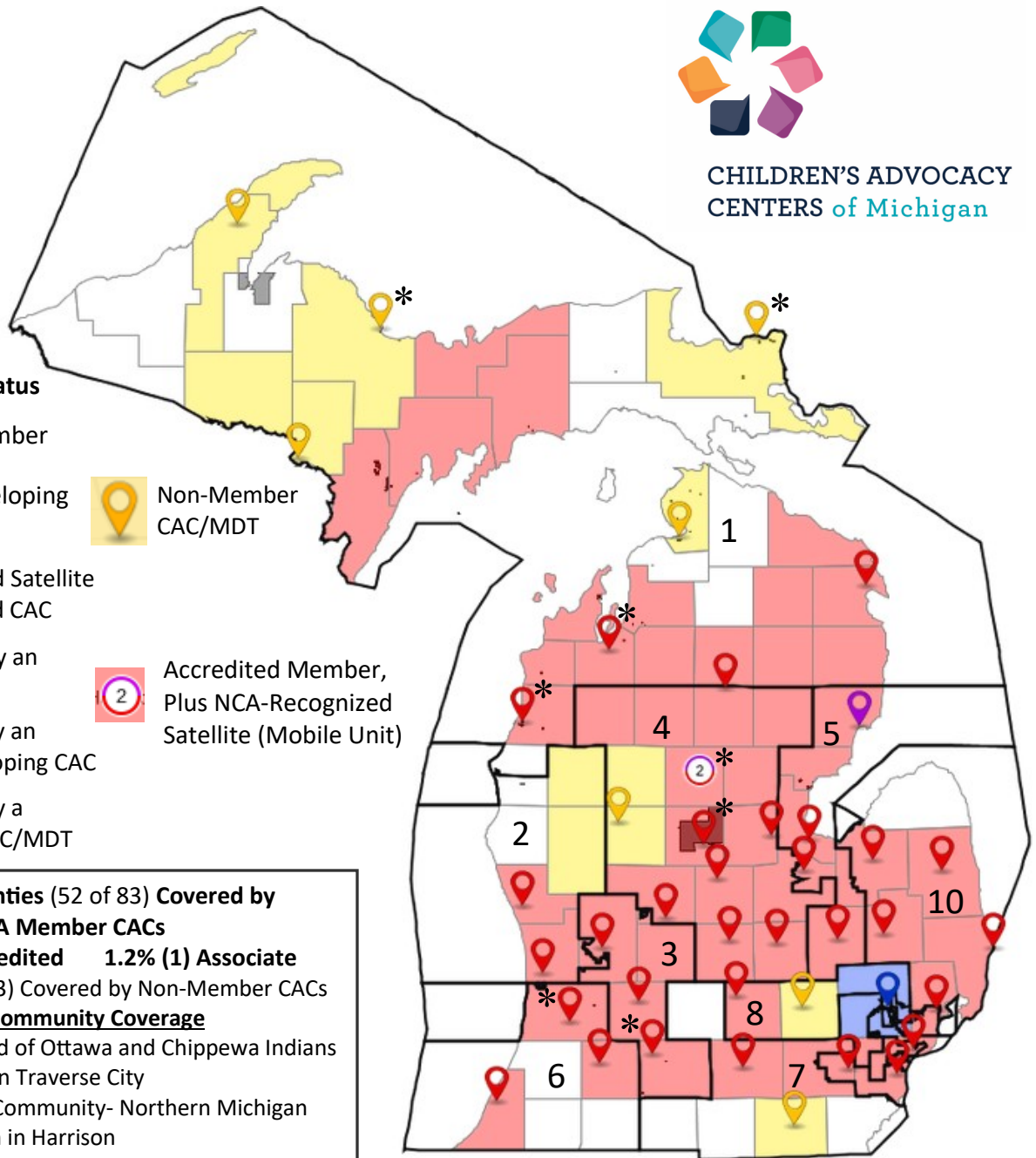
CAC Locations, Coverage Areas by NCA Membership Status Level, Congressional Districts
