NCJTC Course Tuition/Pricing Structure

The National Criminal Justice Training Center has a long history of successfully working with Child Advocacy Centers (CACs) and the multidisciplinary teams that support child sex trafficking (CST) investigations. We have developed a wide variety of training in the area of child abuse and exploitation, including CST, under grants through the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP). We also receive requests from agencies to host training for an audience defined by the requesting agency. These training events are carried out on a cost-recovery basis, meaning that we do not make a profit, but need to recover our costs. Those costs may vary depending upon many factors, including but not limited to the number of instructors needed, number of days the training will occur, virtual versus in-person environment, etc. Requesting agencies will need to work with our highly capable staff members to assess each situation on an individual basis to develop a cost estimate to meet the unique needs of your local or regional CAC or State Chapter.

Child Sex Trafficking

**Child Sex Trafficking – From Suspicion to Disclosure (available in-person and online, instructor-led format)

Description: Learn techniques and strategies to enhance the likelihood of obtaining information from possible victims of child sex trafficking. Compare and contrast typical child sexual abuse cases with child sex trafficking (CST) cases and address the different points of entry into the criminal justice and welfare system for CST victims. Understand various disciplines' roles and responsibilities and how they can contribute to a positive outcome of the CST case. Discuss question strategy, interview dynamics, language use, and interview suggestions.

Length: 1 day, 2 SMEs

**Child Sex Trafficking Forensic Interview Training (available in-person and online, instructorled format)

Description: Develop the skills and techniques to conduct developmentally appropriate forensic interviews with victims of child sex trafficking. Learn the differences between interviewing children in child abuse cases and interviewing child sex trafficking victims. Review victim-centered interview methodology with special emphasis given to understanding the factors contributing to child sex trafficking victimization and the impact on development and effects of trauma.

**Following the Evidence in Child Abuse and Child Exploitation Investigations (available inperson and online, instructor-led format)

Description: Examine the importance of multidisciplinary team (MDT) case coordination and evidence corroboration in the investigation of child abuse cases. Learn how to evaluate evidentiary findings through crime scene images, interviews and case studies. Understand multidisciplinary team members' roles and responsibilities for protecting child victims and offender prosecution.

**Child Abuse – From Suspicion to Disclosure (available in-person and online, instructor-led format)

Develop the skills and techniques necessary to engage a child in such a way as to minimize suggestibility but still provide support, beyond what is taught in a First Responder Training. Review best practices in identification of a concern and learn to engage these children in a way that maximizes positive case outcomes and minimizes potential behaviors that can hurt cases.

**Creating a Community Action Plan for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse (available inperson and online, instructor-led format)

Identify strengths and weaknesses of current prevention practices, and develop an action plan for your organization.
