A universal recognition system for NCA's members, supporters, and partners

National Children's Alliance (NCA) now supplements the longstanding Accredited Member and Accredited Chapter Badges with a new suite of recognition insignia. Badges are now available for all levels of NCA members, plus NCA's partners and supporters of every kind.



Badges for NCA Members

Accredited CACs & Chapters plus other levels of CACs and MDTs in the NCA membership



Badges for NCA Partners

Everyone from foundations to corporations to federal agencies who works with NCA to serve kids



Badges for NCA Supporters

Individuals, communities, and teams who gather their resources to support kids through NCA



Let's start with Accredited Members

NCA's classic Accredited Member Badge and Accredited Chapter Badge are still available–and **required** on important documents and properties such as annual reports, brochures, and websites. This is the national seal of approval that demonstrates a member CAC meets the highest level of service to children and families, or that a State Chapter is managed soundly and effectively.

Accredited CACs and Chapters can and should show their badges with pride-they've earned it.

The Classic Accredited Member Badge

Accreditation Badges include the tagline "Backed by National Children's Alliance," connecting the agency's work to the national CAC movement. Black, white, and single-color formats for digital and print use are available from NCA's BrandFolder. Make sure to use them according to the NCA Brand Guidelines so that they show up beautifully on your designs!

Are you looking for...the logo?

Members and NCA staff sometimes ask for the "NCA logo" to put on their materials. Make sure to ask *which one*! When we redesigned the brand, we renamed this accreditation graphic the "badge" to distinguish it from NCA's organizational logo (seen on the bottom left).



A new way to show your work

In 2023, NCA developed new Accredited Member and Accredited Chapter Badges to match new insignia created for other levels of NCA members. The Alternate Badge is available for use, if desired, in place of the Classic Badge on any or all materials or properties where the Badge is required.

The Alternate Accredited Member Badge

New badges for Every CAC Member

Pride: it's not just for Accredited CACs anymore. Now, every NCA member has a way to show their membership in the national movement of CACs. The below Badges are available for Associate/Developing Centers, Affiliate Centers, and Satellite Centers. For non-Accredited CACs, the Badges are **available for but not required on** important documents and properties such as annual reports, brochures, and websites.



Now, Associate/Developing Centers, Affiliate Centers, and Satellites have their own badges to show their affiliation with the CAC movement!

The New Member Badges

These new style badges mirror the look of new badges for all NCA member levels and partners. A single lockup style makes this look appropriate for all designs and backgrounds. Versions for digital and print use are available from NCA's BrandFolder.

Can I use the "Backed by NCA" Badge?

Accreditation is a difficult and special achievement, so the Classic-style badge is only available for Accredited CACs and Chapters. We believe you can get there and your Chapter can help. Reach out to our Accreditation team for help getting that highest-level badge!



Now, for some extra credit!

In 2023, NCA introduced three optional standards, giving CACs the opportunity to develop their programs in the areas of physical abuse intervention, prevention services, and services to commercially sexually exploited children (CSEC). Now, with the Optional Standards Achievement Badges, you can show off your achievement of one, two, or all three Optional Standards.



Show off all the ways in which you excel...and get credit for it, too.

The Optional Standards Achievement Badges

These new-style badges mirror the look of new badges for all NCA member levels, with 1, 2, or 3 added ribbons for Optional Standards achievement. A single lockup style makes this look appropriate for all designs and backgrounds.

Because of the rarity and difficulty of achieving the Optional Standards, versions for digital and print use are available from NCA Accreditation staff only.

Not for Chapters...yet

There aren't any Optional Standards for Chapters yet, so these Badges are for CACs only. Chapters, make sure your CACs who have achieved Optional Standards are using the Badge that proves it!



For partners who help **build our movement**,

Badges are available for all the different kinds of partners who help shape, support, and spread the work CACs do to heal kids.



Foundation Partners

These private funding institutions provide resources for NCA's statewide, regional, and national projects.



Mission Partners

These nonprofit institutions work alongside NCA toward our common goal of better futures for kids.



Education Partners

These academic institutions work with NCA to develop and spread best practices to CACs and communities.





• Public Policy Partners

These institutions, like Regional CACs and VOCAA partners, help the child welfare field broadly define strategies to use resources effectively.

Federal Partners

These federal agencies support CACs through grants, MOUs, partnerships, and in many other ways.


