## Data you need

Outcome Measurement System (OMS) data offers an integrated evaluation system where individual CACs can collect feedback from youth, caregivers, and MDT partners. CACs use OMS data to find bright spots to celebrate, identify areas for improvement, and benchmark themselves against the field.

NCA's CAC Census and Chapter Census, completed every two years, are comprehensive snapshots of the CAC movement and help to identify trends.

The *CAC Staffing and Salary Report* provides key findings about CAC salaries, staffing levels, workloads, and benefits—valuable insights that CACs and Chapters can use in recruiting and retaining staff.

## Networking opportunities
